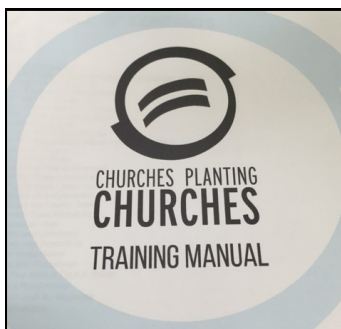


Hong Kong. Even though Christian education is still very much a part of GCIM's emphasis, we believe that there is an even greater need in the area of planting churches.
