In July, our ministry team traveled to North-east China to hold an 11-day conference for church workers, church leaders and RBTC alumni. Over 90 people gathered together for times of worship, prayer and Bible training.

The majority of those who attended our conference were hearing RHEMA's teaching for the first time. It was a joy to see how

hungry the attendees were and to witness their joyful expressions after hearing the truth of God's Word.

We also used this conference to meet with several of our RBTC China alumni. We took time to answer questions and to give them some insights concerning the future of our work in China. It was exciting to be able to hear from each of them concerning how God is using them in different types of ministry in the northeast region of the country.



Because another key purpose of this conference was to record courses that will ultimately be used for our RHEMA Chinese online program, the conference will bear fruit not only in those who were present, but also in many others in the future, too. We were able to record two complete courses, as well as some specialized subjects that will be used for our continuing education program.

I want to especially thank Rev. Amos Wong, who served as our main teacher for the conference, Sarah Van Dreese, our GCIM Office Administrator, who traveled all the way to China to oversee the video and audio recordings, and Wayne Li, who recently joined our team as a translator. We are blessed to have a growing team for the ongoing work in China as well as for the online program. Without their involvement and commitment, as well as our Stateside office team and partners, it would be impossible to do the work the Lord has directed us to do in China and Asia.
