Over 17 couples, all pastors, attended this conference. Pastor Mike and I took turns



teaching practical and spiritual issues that currently affect pastors and churches. We heard many testimonies from the attendees and host on how fruitful this conference was.



While in Greece and Albania, we also had the opportunity to teach several courses at RBTC Athens, RBTC Thessaloniki and RBTC Albania.

have all of the current RBTC Directors and Campus Directors present at this seminar. We believe this conference will assist in promoting church planting throughout the nation of India.
