


2018 Summer Updates

A Fresh Look for GCIM We're excited to announce the upcoming launch of our new GCIM website. This has been a long journey, but we are finally going live with our updated ministry website in August. We encourage you to visit www.gcinternational.org and explore all of the new sections that have been added. You will notice a new look with our logo, as well as to the overall site layout.



Among our new pages is a section that offers GCIM products, such as "Discovering the Plan of God Through Prayer", but for the first time ever, all of our GCIM resources will be offered as free downloads!

We have also added a new Chinese resource area. In this section, we will have a sampling of Chinese materials, such as "The New Birth" mini-book, available as free downloads, as well as information on how to acquire some of our other newly translated Chinese FLP books for wholesale. We hope to offer these Chinese FLP books for general sale in the future as well. We are looking for every opportunity to equip Chinese-speaking people with the life-changing truths of God's Word. In the near future, we also plan to offer short GCIM video teachings that will cover a wide variety of subjects. All of the various videos and resource materials are being made available for the purpose of reaching people with the Gospel as well as to offer ongoing spiritual resources to bless our friends and partners.

We have also added a new "Projects Page" to our website highlighting many of our ongoing projects, including book translations and other GCIM needs. You will be able to give directly to the project of your choice. You will also be able to view the progress and completion

Online Project Update We are very close to concluding our first phase of testing for our RHEMA Chinese Online program. As you know, we have had a host of people working on this project for over five years, now, so we are thrilled to have a plan to do our initial launch of the first-phase, free-side of the program sometime this fall.

The RHEMA Chinese Online program will have two main tracks. The first track contains 12 courses, 6 hours in length, that will be freely available to any Chinese speaker. This track will be the first to be launched this fall.



Later, an additional 6 hours per course will be added for those who desire to take courses for credit yet still at a minimal cost to the student.

Of course, there will be ongoing testing and tweaking of things so that we can maintain a program of excellence and offer an online option that is as user-friendly as possible.

We will have more details about the launch in our fall newsletter including a website address where you can view things first-hand.

Impacting New Nations In July, we had the privilege of ministering at Nejat Church, a Persian-speaking congregation based in the Seattle area that also impacts Iranian people living around the world via the internet and through satellite television broadcasts.

Nejat Church is pastored by Rev. Massoud and Sarah Sedighi, 2006 RBTC USA graduates. Locally, they are doing an amazing work among the Persian speaking people of Seattle, WA, and Vancouver, BC pioneering churches in both locations. They are a loving and vibrant community of believers excited about how they can reach their world with the Gospel.



We were greatly honored to be guests at Nejat Church and to impact the Iranian Christian community in Seattle and abroad. We

were told that the message that we shared at the church was later broadcast by satellite into the country of Iran.


Book Translation Accelerating

As you know from previous newsletters and various updates, GCIM has been working diligently on translating a number of Kenneth

Hagin's books into the Simplified Chinese language. We have made progress on several titles, including making important revisions to certain works, but we SUICA still have many titles yet to complete.



Our current goal is to have the 23 books we intend to use in connection with our for-credit online program completed by the end of next year. When considering titles that we are in final editing stages with, we are close to having completed 11 out of the 23. We have an ambitious plan to not only make these titles available for our online program, but also in hardcopy and e-book formats.



The process involved in producing a quality translation is very time consuming, but our goal has always been to provide the most accurate translation possible, so we believe the time and effort we've spent has been worthwhile. We are very thankful to

Wayne Li, who has put in literally hundreds of hours translating and editing the majority of our books.

We are also thankful to our partners for helping us financially with these goals. This translation project is among the things noted on the project page of our new website. It's a wonderful way to help give toward the completion of a particular book that may have had a personal impact on your life.
