## Asia Connections...Old and New

Our launch into spring started with a four-week journey to Asia where we impacted four different nations, starting in Hong Kong.

While there, I joined Pastor Amos Wong, Director of RHEMA China and Hong Kong, as he shared his vision of planting churches in



every province of the neighboring country. He also confirmed plans to begin two new training centers using our graduates from that country to teach and oversee the operations of these new locations. We had an awesome time of fellowship, ministry and prayer.

Amos, Doris and I also had the opportunity to meet with many of our RBTC Hong Kong Alumni. Pastor Amos encouraged the alumni to be open to the leading of the Lord concerning how God may want to use them to make an impact in Hong Kong and neighboring countries.



Our next stop was Vietnam, my first time visiting this country. Connie was not able to join me for this trip, but I had my friend Denis Goulet, a 2004 RBTC graduate from the States, traveling with me.

Over the course of a week, Denis and I had the opportunity to share with local expats, alumni and with current students who are enrolled in a biblical education program.

We were blessed to be hosted by John and Cindy McKinney. They have been living in Vietnam since 2016. Cindy has had the opportunity to share at the local Embassy and both she and John are touching lives there in special ways.



Connie joined me for the final leg of our journey when we travelled on to India. When first arriving we connected with Kevin and Areni Castro, Pastors of Living Word International Church and the directors of RBTC Mumbai. We had a ministry-packed week beginning with a Leadership Conference, which was a first for the ministry in Mumbai.



Another first was an RBTC Alumni meeting which brought together alumni from RBTC Mumbai and other campus loca-

tions. Connie encouraged the alumni to stay connected, stay faithful and stay open to what God has for their lives. Gary had the honor of teaching the students at both RBTC Mumbai campus locations, as well.

Our second stop in India was in the Northern State of Punjab where we were hosted by Sushil and Monica Kumar. There we were blessed to be a part of a week-long conference for pastors and RBTC alumni. Over 150 people attended a power-packed week of services.
