We had a full Stateside schedule this summer, but beginning October 1st, Connie and I will be on an extended international trip that

will take us to five different nations. We have ministry stops scheduled at various locations in Hong Kong, Thailand, India, Greece and Albania.

While in Thailand, Connie and I have the honor of speaking at RHEMA Bible Church Bangkok's 20th anniversary celebration. In 1999, Connie and I, along with a great team of RBTC USA graduates, relocated to Bangkok, Thailand to establish a local church and Bible school.



Two years later, Connie and I relocated to Singapore to pioneer again, but the ministry in Thailand was assumed by the wonderful leadership



of Glenn and Beth Hardeman and then Keith and Sharon Higginbotham. Under their direction, the school and church have grown significantly.

RHEMA Bangkok is making a significant impact in Thailand and the surrounding nations. Over 90 churches have been planted by their graduates in Thailand and neighboring Myanmar.

We are tremendously excited to be a part of this anniversary service and to experience the great things taking place through this ministry.

From Thailand, we travel to India for a one week pastor's conference. GCIM, along with Tom Harrington, pastor of

Living River Church in Louisville, Colorado, will co-host this conference for 150 pastors who are coming from a very persecuted region of India. We are especially excited about this opportunity because the majority of these pastors have never experienced a conference like this. We will be giving each pastor several faith-building books and an mp3 player that will contain all the messages and ministry from the conference. Thanks to many of our partners and Pastor Tom Harrington's church, all of the provision has come in so we can underwrite the entire cost of hosting this conference.

Pray for our protection and for the anointing as we teach and minister. Believe with us that the Holy Spirit will do significant work in each pastor.

From India, we travel on to Greece where we will spend some time with our wonderful friend Spyros Voulgaris, as well as his church and ministry team there and in



Albania. We will be speaking in their local church as well as teaching in two different Bible school locations. We are always blessed to have the opportunity to invest in the lives of many beautiful people in that part of the world.

Amos and Doris first began working with us in 1999 when we relocated to Bangkok, Thailand to establish a church and Bible school there. Amos and Doris committed to partner with us in reaching that nation with the Gospel twenty years ago and have been faithfully serving God through all these years.

Later in 1999, Amos and I took our first trip into China. From that day until now, Amos and Doris have focused their efforts



and resources on that great nation. In 2008, while we were living in China, God reconnected Connie and I with Amos and Doris again. We began working together, planning together, and dreaming together about reaching the world'slargest populated nation with the same teaching that changed our lives.



In 2016, Amos and Doris became the International RBTC Directors of China. From that time,

Amos and Doris assumed the full RBTC leadership position of establishing schools, teaching in conferences, and developing resources for Chinesespeaking people around the world.



Over the past 20 years, Amos and Doris have taken innumerable ministry trips into China. They have a passion and a love for Chinese people that has compelled them to

give all for the sake of reaching Chinese-speaking people with the Gospel. They have ministered in house churches, government churches, Bible studies, conferences, businessmen's meetings, marriage seminars... any doors that open to them.

They have touched countless numbers of mainland Chinese, as well as Chinese in Taiwan, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia,



Canada and the US. They continue speak in churches and conferences anywhere there are Chinese people. This calling has consumed them to the point that this is their primary calling.
