At the end of every year, we share a brief highlight of what GCIM has accomplished. Below is a list of highlights from 2019 and a shortlist of upcoming ministry for 2020.

2019 Ministry Highlights

- We beta tested our RHEMA Bible Training College Online Program in the Chinese Language. The testing and release of phase one have gone smoothly.
- We continued producing materials for phase two of the Online Program.
- ✓ We completed layout work and the first-run publications for our Simplified Chinese translations of "Grace the DNA of God" by Tony Cook and "The Art of Prayer" by Kenneth E. Hagin.
- We added six new free downloadable audio teachings from the GCIM ministry archives on our website.
- ✓ We ministered at "Partner Churches" in Oklahoma, Colorado, California, Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Tennessee, Kentucky, Florida, Texas, Georgia, Michigan, and Kansas.
- We ministered at two locations in the Toronto, Canada area.
- ✓ We ministered in Vietnam at a Bible school and local ministry.
- We ministered in both the spring and fall in India. During the first trip, we ministered at a Bible School Alumni Fellowship. On our second trip, we focused our ministry time to train and exhort approximately 80 church leaders from a persecuted region of the country.
- We traveled to Thailand where we shared at a three-day "Supernatural Leadership Conference." We also participated in RHEMA Bible Church's 20th Anniversary celebration and ministered at a church camp hosted by RHEMA Bible Church Bangkok.
- We ministered in Greece for three weeks teaching four Bible courses in two cities.
 We also participated in a 10th Anniversary celebration service for a church in Athens.



- \checkmark China training program for pastors and church leaders.
- Myanmar teaching at Bible schools in two locations along with additional conferences for pastors.
- ✓ India hosting a pastor's conference in one location and teaching at an alumni meeting in a different location.
- \checkmark Vietnam local ministry and teaching in a Bible school.
- ✓ One and three-day conferences in local churches and locations throughout the US.
- ✓ Other international trips to different regions of the world.

Fruitful Results in 2019— This past year was a great year of ministry and fruitfulness. We experienced an increase in people receiving Jesus for the first time. We also saw an increase of individuals receiving the baptism with the Holy Spirit and individuals receiving instant healing in their bodies.

Our ministry time in churches and pastor's conferences saw an increase of anointing and manifestations of the Holy Spirit. We believe that this increase is not only directly connected to what God has called us to do, but is also the result of your prayers.



We know that you are praying for us, and we greatly appreciate it. We can sense your prayers as we travel and minister, especially in countries that require us to be sensitive to how we communicate the Gospel. As we enter this new year, we covet your prayers even more. The Lord has spoken some specific assignments for us to accomplish, and we know that these assignments will not

happen without your prayers. Thank you again for the supply of the Spirit that you are making through your partnership.
