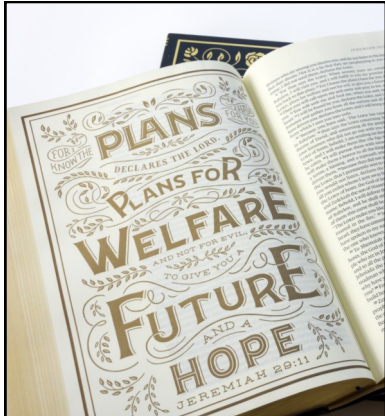




2020 Spring Newsletter

The Cause

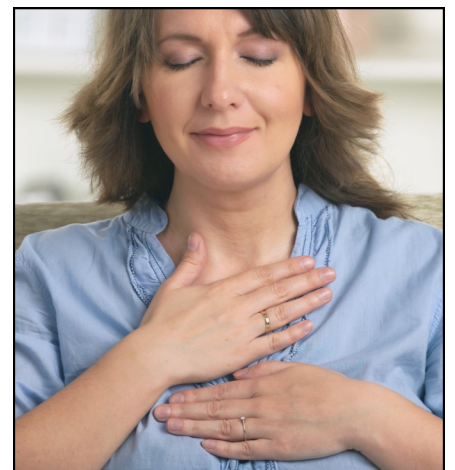
Romans 5:12 "Sin came into the world through one man, and his sin brought death with it..."

Ministry in China Continues

Due to the recent outbreak of the coronavirus, all foreigners are currently restricted from traveling to China. It has also been challenging for Christians to assemble or to have church gatherings. Fortunately, through technology, we can still have an impact.

Over the past few months, Amos Wong, the Director of RHEMA China, has been in contact with many of our graduates and pastors, the majority of whom live in NE China. Amos has been using an online conferencing platform to maintain personal contact. We want our graduates to know that God has not forsaken them. Instead, God wants to use them to bring the message of faith and the healing power of God to their nation.



In April, Amos will begin conducting Bible school classes using the online conferencing platform. This technology allows Amos to do live teaching and interact with the students. At this time, there are between 40 to 45 individuals who have signed up for these classes. Please continue to pray for the nation of China and especially for our graduates who are on the front lines of ministry. Please also pray for Amos Wong as he begins these new training programs via the internet.
