In all, 28 students graduated – 10 students from Thessaloniki, 1 student from Rhodes, and 17 students from Athens. It is always a joy to be a part of an RBTC Graduation. We sensed the same Spirit of Faith and the same standard of excellence at each RBTC

graduation we attended. Pastor Spyros Voulgaris and his team are outstanding! Connie and I also had the privilege of ministering at his church Sunday morning: Logos Church Athens. It is an awesome church making a major impact in Athens and throughout the nation of Greece.

After our Sunday morning service in Athens, we flew to Crete to minister Sunday night at a new work that was established by Pastor Spyros: Logos Church, Crete. We were blessed to share the Word of God with this new church! The last time we were in Crete to visit the new church plant, they were still meeting in a house for services. During this trip, however, we had the privilege of ministering in their new building.





Next, Connie and I travelled to Albania to speak to the RBTC Albania Graduating Class of 2022. This was Albania's first graduation! We rejoice with these 27 graduates who persevered for almost five years to complete their program. Immediately after the graduation ceremony, we held a special service with the guests and pastors who attended the graduation. Our final meeting was held back at Logos Church, Athens Greece, pastored by Spyros Voulgaris. 

Praying For Nations: We Need Seed, Rain, and Harvesters...



We live in one of the most wonderful and exciting times in the history of the world. More people are living on the earth today than have lived and died from the time of Jesus Christ until now. Over seven billion people live on this planet, and one-third of the world's population is centered in two countries, China and India. China has a population of approximately 1.4 billion, and the population of India is approximately 1.3 billion. These are two of the nations God has put on our hearts.

If you draw a circle on a map of the world around China, India, and Southeast Asia, more people live inside than outside that circle. What a tremendous opportunity to preach the gospel and to reap a harvest of souls for the kingdom of God in that part of the world! James 5:7 reveals that God is waiting for a great harvest of souls to be reaped before He returns. We have an amazing opportunity to be a part of this great harvest.

There are three areas of prayer in connection with reaping the harvest that we need to consider.

Number One— **PRAY FOR THE SEED** (The Word of God to be planted and have free course.) 2 Thess. 3:1 - Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you.

Number Two— **PRAY FOR THE RAIN OF THE HOLY SPIRIT** — Zech. 10:1 - Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain... Charles Finney said, "A revival is no more a miracle than a crop of wheat — soil must be prepared — seed must be planted — the rain must fall."

Number Three— **PRAY FOR LABORERS** — Matt. 9:35-38 - And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when he saw the multi-

tudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

We are co-laborers together, with the Holy Spirit and with you. Thank you for praying and for partnering with us as we shape leaders, reach nations...and bring in His harvest.
