Sowing and Reaping in South East Asia

In March, I had the opportunity to travel to my favorite place in the world, South East Asia! I spent one week in Singapore with my good friends, Pastor Amos and Doris

Wong. Pastor Amos and I have worked together in Asia for over thirteen years, and Amos now serves as the Director of RHEMA China. Amos and Doris also pastor New Rise Church (newrise.online), a Chinesespeaking church they planted in Singapore two years ago. They continue reaching into the Chinese community in South East Asia and Mainland China and are significantly impacting their part of the world.

From Singapore, I flew to Hanoi, Vietnam to spend a week with RHEMA graduates who have lived and worked in Vietnam for seven years. I am grateful to them for arranging many meetings with

various groups in that nation, including speaking at a men's rehabilitation center, a staff training, an alumni meeting, and two Bible training programs. Vietnam is a nation of 98 million people. It is the 15th most populated nation in the world. Now is the time to invest in this nation while there is a move of God taking place. It is on our hearts to help that move continue so that the spiritual harvest can be reaped.

Expanding Our Reach and Resources

Connecting to Nations Through Online Platforms One positive result of the pandemic restrictions was the development of various means of virtual communication. Even though live training is our preferred method of communication, it is apparent that this form of connecting and training will be with us for many years to come.

In March, I taught a college course for several individuals in Greece who are completing their degree



plans. Later in March, I was invited to participate in a special *Day of Prayer* for a group in Chandigarh, India. Then, in April, I taught a college-level course to students in Thailand and South East Asia. All were done through Zoom.

New GCIM Teaching Resource From time-to-time we share new teaching resources that are collected from our live teaching events in churches. We have released three since the start of 2023.



One of those new resources is a teaching on the importance of local churches and how they impact communities and nations. In this teaching, we emphasize that every member of the Body of Christ has a purpose and function that is specifically related to the God-given gift or ability given to them by the Holy Spirit. FLP stands for *Faith Library Publications* and is the source of all of the Kenneth Hagin Ministries teaching resources. *FLPChinese.com* hosts the Chinese translations of these materials with free, downloadable books, audio teachings, and other faith-based resources. We will continue to translate books and materials that we feel will make the most



significant spiritual impact in the lives of Chinese church leaders and pastors worldwide.

Our newest releases in 2023 so far include the book *Seven Steps to Judging Prophecy* (shown above) and a video teaching, *The Precious Blood of Jesus*. The dedication of Wayne Li and his team to accurately translate these materials has been remarkable.

First quarter statistics confirm that the majority of our downloads are still coming from China, but in 2023 we've also had download activity from Hong Kong, Taiwan, Canada, Malaysia, Australia, Japan, Singapore, the United Kingdom, Germany, South Korea, and the Philippines. Our first quarter totals brought us to 87,553 downloads overall. Only eternity will tell of the far-reaching impact these materials have made. Our partners make it possible.
